KS3 Home Learning



In KS 3 Subject teachers set learners tasks to complete at home to:

develop individual study skills
encourage the motivation to learn
reinforce learning in class

In KS3 learners should spend up to 30 minutes on each subject.

The home learning timetable will show when tasks will be set in each subject. It is important to organise home learning carefully and complete activities on time.

Learners are expected to complete learning activities to the best of their ability.

All learners have a planner to record details of their home learning activities. We ask parents and carers to take a regular interest in home learning and sign the planners every week, this will strengthen the partnership between home and school.

We trust that all parents and carers will support their children by ensuring that they have a suitable place to study and encouraging them to take a pride in their learning.

If a learner loses or defaces his/her planner a paper booklet replacement must be purchased (£3.00).

Learners can attend the Learning resource centre at break time, lunch time or after school to complete home learning tasks and get support from the Pastoral team.
