This term our new topic is 'World War Two'.

In our World War Two unit, students will be learning about the causes of the war, major countries involved, key events, and how the conflict affected people around the world and shaped modern history.

This topic fosters curiosity and compassion, helping students ask thoughtful questions and understand others' experiences.

Language and Communication

Our language lessons will be based on our class book 'Carrie's War' which is about a little girl who is evacuated from London to Wales with her younger brother Nick.

The genres we will be covering are:

- Setting descriptions.
- Writing flashbacks.
- Planning and writing a story.
- Biographies.

Maths and Numeracy

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In our mathematic lessons we will be covering:

- Fractions (finding equivalents, comparing and ordering, adding and subtracting).
- Converting metric measurements.
- Ratio and proportion.
- Algebra.
- Decimals (rounding, adding and subtracting).

Health and Wellbeing

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We will be discussing:

- Spoken and unspoken pressures from peers.
- How their thoughts, feelings and actions can impact our own well-being, friendships and relationships with others.
- Concepts of fairness, bullying, discrimination and prejudice.

On week 1, PE will be on a Monday. On week 2, PE will be on a Wednesday. Our PE topics will be gymnastics and fitness.

Religious Education

In our Religious Education lessons, we will:

- Create a Hall of Fame for Women in the Old Testament.
- Complete key teachings about Wedding Feast at Cana.
- Plan and lead a Visio Divina.
- Discuss the Trial of Jesus. Look at and discuss Jesus' trial fact file.

We will also have daily Celebration of the Word and a weekly Celebration of the Word assembly.

Thematic Work

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In our Topic lessons, we will:

- Analyse a range of primary and secondary sources.
- Investigate translucent materials to create a safe Anderson Shelter.
- Understand rationing and home front roles by exploring ration booklets.
- Learn about enigma, radar and aircrafts used in WW2 and then crack codes.
